Fire Pump Operations II Scenarios

Description: This class is designed for firefighters who have completed Fire Pump Operations class. Firefighters taking Fire Pump Operations II will operate fire pumps based on scenarios from actual fire incidents.

- Scenario #1 – Discharging to multiple handlines and master stream devices with water supplied from draft
- Scenario #2 - Discharging to multiple handlines and master stream devices with water supplied from hydrants
- Scenario #3 - Discharging to multiple handlines and master stream devices with water supplied from relay using Hydrant Assist Valve

Fire pump operators will operate pumps based on instructions from Incident Command via radio communications. Instructors will observe operations from a distance and will monitor to ensure safe operations. Fire pump operators will make decisions regarding supplying discharge lines based on the knowledge and skills achieved from Fire Pump Operations class.
