

TRAINING

Rhode Island Fire Academy Fire Pump Operations I & II

This is a 19-hour program that provides both classroom and practical applications in the operation of fire pumps. Training is based on the pump operator's perspective while operating at incidents.

- Scenario #1 – Discharging to multiple handlines and master stream devices with water supplied from draft
- Scenario #2 - Discharging to multiple handlines and master stream devices with water supplied from hydrants
- Scenario #3 - Discharging to multiple handlines and master stream devices with water supplied from relay using Hydrant Assist Valve

Fire pump operators will operate pumps based on instructions from Incident Command via radio communications. Instructors will observe operations from a distance and will monitor to ensure safe operations. Fire pump operators will make decisions regarding supplying discharge lines based on the knowledge and skills achieved from Fire Pump Operations class.
